The Second Meeting of the Society will be held at 8.00pm on Monday 26th February 2018 when Professor David Rosin MS MB BS FRCS FICS FCCS will deliver the Lettsomian Lecture on

ROYAL POXES POTIONS AND PROCEDURES

David Rosin was born in Zimbabwe and was educated at St George's Jesuit College. He studied medicine in England, qualifying at the Westminster Hospital School of Medicine, University of London. Wishing to follow in his father's footsteps in surgery, he was fortunate to be taught and guided by Professor Harold Ellis from whom he also gained a love of the history of medicine. He was appointed Consultant Surgeon with a special interest in Surgical Oncology to St Mary's Hospital, Imperial College School of Medicine in 1979 where he worked until 2007. He pioneered outpatient flexible endoscopy designing the first endoscopy suite at St Hellier Hospital and was the first surgeon to implant a pump for the delivery of chemotherapy to the liver and the first to perform a laparoscopic cholecystectomy in England. In 2008 he was appointed Professor to the University of the West Indies, Barbados where he is till teaching and operating.

This lecture will trace some of the diseases and cures of the Royal Family through the ages. It will begin with the first King who suffered from a pox, Henry VIII, whose reign witnessed great advances in professional medicine to King George VI who, due to heavy smoking, suffered from both arterial disease and lung cancer.
