The next Society meeting of the 2024/25 session will be held on **Monday 9th February 2026**, where Mr Joseph Manjaly BSc MBChB DOHNS FRCS (ORL-HNS) will deliver his lecture on:

'HEARING AND DEAFNESS: WHY IT MATTERS AND WHAT WE CAN DO IN 2026'

Joe Manjaly is a Consultant Otologist, Auditory Implant and ENT Surgeon. He is Clinical Lead for Adult ENT at the Royal National ENT Hospital & University College London Hospitals. He graduated from Bristol University in 2008 and underwent ENT Higher surgical training on the London North Thames rotation followed by an advanced fellowship in Otology & Auditory Implants at University Hospitals Cambridge. He specialises in stapedectomy under sedation as well as cochlear, middle ear & bone conduction implantation for adults & children. He is the author of a number of popular trainee textbooks, including 'ENT OSCES' & 'Advanced ENT Training' both published by CRC press. He is a council member for the British Society of Otology. He creates a variety of educational social media content on various channels as @earsurgeonjoe

The association between hearing loss and cognitive decline has received significant spotlight in recent years. Even before this though, we know that unmanaged hearing loss has significant impact on social life, professional life, relationships and mental health. The medical options available for listening augmentation have evolved hugely in even the past few years, and with that so have attitudes to wearable hearing technology. This talk will cover all of the various options available to patients in 2026, including middle ear hearing restoration surgery, non-surgical devices and auditory implant technology.
